PLAN I

5 BOOKS PER YEAR

- One book from each category: Education for Mission, Leadership Development, Nurturing for Community, Social Action and Spiritual Growth.
- Regular reading of response magazine.

PLAN III

15 BOOKS PER YEAR

- Two books from each category: Education for Mission, Leadership Development, Nurturing for Community, Social Action and Spiritual Growth.
- Plus five additional books from any category.
- Regular reading of response magazine.

PLAN II

10 BOOKS PER YEAR

- Two books from each category: Education for Mission, Leadership Development, Nurturing for Community, Social Action and Spiritual Growth.
- Regular reading of response magazine.

PLAN IV

20 BOOKS PER YEAR

- Two books from each category: Education for Mission, Leadership Development, Nurturing for Community, Social Action and Spiritual Growth.
- Plus 10 additional books from any category.
- Regular reading of response magazine.

Information: Bonus Books, Movies, & Mission U Sessions

Bonus books are interesting, but not all are equal in value! There is a category notation in the front of Bonus Books that are in the Southern Hills UMW library.

Bonus Books in the categories of Education for Mission and Social Action may count as 2 books in one category (for Plan 2, 3, 4) or 1 book in each of those two categories for Plan 1. However, Bonus Books in the categories of Nurturing for Community and Spiritual Growth can be counted only for one category if the reader is reading for Plan 1. In this case, the Bonus Book would apply for the Plan 1 and as an "additional book". (For a total of 6 books read.) Readers could consider a goal of Plan 2 where 1 Bonus Book could qualify as 2 books in the identified category.

If a UMW member watches a movie based on a book on the Reading List, that counts at having read the book! This is true for single count and Bonus Books.

Similarly, UMW members can attend or watch a recorded Mission U session that is based on Reading List books. Two seminars equals 1 book and 3 seminars equals 2 books.
